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: **CONSENT ORDER**  
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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information from Riverview Medical Center Pharmacy Department that respondent was terminated in April of 2007 for diversion of Percocet, a Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substance, from the active drug stock of Riverview Medical Center for her own consumption. She is currently in treatment for her admitted chemical dependency.

It appearing that in lieu of a proceeding to suspend respondent's license to practice pharmacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, respondent has agreed to surrender her original certificate and license renewal pending further order of the Board, and

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS** on this *3<sup>RD</sup>* day of *August*, 2007,

**ORDERED AND AGREED**, pending further order of the Board, that the license of Susan Schatzle, R.P., to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey, is hereby suspended. Respondent may not make application for reinstatement of license until she can demonstrate a minimum of 6 months of sobriety, and it is further

**ORDERED AND AGREED**, Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; she shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; she shall not handle prescriptions; she shall not advise or consult with patients; and she is prohibited from being present within the prescription filling area of a pharmacy; and it is further

**ORDERED AND AGREED**, upon application for reinstatement, respondent shall submit documentation satisfactory to the Board inclusive of, but not limited to, weekly, random, witnessed urine screens for a minimum of six (6) months, complete treatment records

of all diagnostic and rehabilitative therapy and an in-depth, current evaluation from a Board approved psychiatrist or psychologist.

The Board reserves the right to take any further action authorized by law.
