TO PRACTICE PHARMACY IN THE	:

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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that on May 2, 2006, respondent was arrested by the Paulsboro Police Department and charged with the following offenses: (1) Theft by unlawfully taking or exercising control over certain moveable property, to wit, Hydrocodone 5/325, Hydrocodone 10/325, Hydrocodone 10/500 and Celebrex 200 mg belonging to the CVS Pharmacy with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, specifically by taking these items from the store without paying for or having the authorization to do so in violation of N.J.S. 2C:20-3A; (2) knowingly or purposely obtaining or possessing Hydrocodone without a valid prescription,

in violation of N.J.S. 2C:35-24; (3) forging at least three prescriptions for Hydrocodone in his own name and filling same which also resulted in defrauding his insurance company through CVS as he was an employee there, in violation of N.J.S. 2C:21-2A(2).

On July 13, 2007, respondent entered into a pretrial intervention agreement with the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office which included the condition that (4) respondent shall forfeit his pharmacy license, original wall certificate, his wallet certificate, and his most recent renewal card of his license to an authorized representative of the Board. The Board having reviewed the terms of the agreement and finding respondent's conduct to be violative of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) and respondent waiving his right to a hearing and the parties agreeing the resolution is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare,

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2007,

ORDERED AND AGREED, that the license of Kenneth W. Grossett, II, R.P., to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey, is hereby revoked, and he shall immediately surrender his pharmacy license, original wall certificate and most recent renewal card to an authorized representative of the Board, and it is further

ORDERED AND AGREED, respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count,

fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with patients; and he is prohibited from being present within the prescription filling area of a pharmacy.
