

Administrative Action

CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("the Board") upon receipt of information that Anthony Intersimone ("respondent"), signed and sealed a plumbing permit for use by a person other than the State licensed master plumber to whom it was issued. The Board received information alleging respondent took out a permit to perform plumbing work for a residence in Wanaque, New Jersey. It was later learned that respondent did not perform all the plumbing work. Instead, an individual who was not licensed to practice plumbing and was not employed by the respondent did some of the plumbing work. The work subsequently failed inspection.

Respondent submitted a letter to the Board in response to a request for information regarding the matter. Respondent admitted he subcontracted the plumbing work to an individual

who was not licensed or employed by respondent. He stated he did not know his actions were impermissible but he accepted responsibility.

These facts establish a basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.4, in that any plumbing work that a licensed master plumber agrees to perform, that has not been subcontracted to another licensed master plumber, may be performed only by the licensed master plumber or the employee of the licensed master plumber or the plumbing contractor.

Additionally, these facts establish a basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:32-4.1(c), in that use of a seal by any person other than the State licensed master plumber to whom it was issued or the securing of a plumbing permit for an unlicensed person constitutes the use or employment of dishonesty, fraud, deception, misrepresentation or false pretense pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b).

It appearing that respondent desires to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings, having waived any right to such proceedings and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS *11* DAY OF *OCTOBER*, 2007

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,250 for subcontracting plumbing work to a person who was not a licensed master plumber or employed by the respondent in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.4. Additionally, respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,250 for signing and sealing a plumbing permit for use by a person other than the State licensed master plumber to whom it was issued in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-4.1(c). Payment for the civil penalties totaling \$2,500 shall be submitted in monthly installments of \$500 beginning simultaneous with the signing of this order, and then on the first of every month thereafter over a period of four (4) months. All payments are to be by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be sent to Barbara Cook, Executive Director, Board of

Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

2. Respondent shall cease and desist from the violations described herein. Subsequent violations will subject respondent to enhanced penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25.

3. Failure to timely remit any and all payments required by this order will result in the filing of a certificate of debt with interest accruing at the rate provided by the Rules of Court, and may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, which could include the suspension or revocation of license.
