TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL
COUNSELING IN THE STATE
OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened before the Professional Counselor Examiners Committee (hereinafter "the Committee") of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon review of Ms. Colleen G. Fallon's application for licensure as a Professional Counselor. Ms. Fallon disclosed in her

application that she is not licensed and has been working as a counselor in a for-profit setting under the supervision of Ms. Lisa Lynne Crispino, LPC, LCADC. Ms. Crispino completed the Documentation of Supervised Counseling Experience, stating that she supervised 12,480 hours of counseling services performed by Ms. Fallon at Guiding Light Behavioral Health, Inc. Further Ms. Crispino submitted a letter to the Committee, dated January 11, 2007 stating that she supervised Ms. Fallon since 2000 and that Ms. Fallon was responsible for direct clinical management of approximately 12 clients at any given time. Ms. Crispino has advised the Committee that she also supervised two other counselors who were not licensed, Kristy Ryan and Natalie Randan.

It appears to the Committee that Ms. Crispino, as the supervisor of unlicensed counselors, aided and abetted the unlicensed practice of professional counseling. Ms. Crispino permitted and supervised counseling in a for-profit setting despite the counselors' lack of associate professional licenses which would have entitled Ms. Fallon, Ms. Ryan and Ms. Randan to provide such services in a for-profit setting in New Jersey. Having reviewed the entire record, it appears to the Committee that respondent has aided and abetted the unlicensed practice of professional counseling in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(n) and N.J.S.A. 45:8B-39(a). It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Committee finding this Consent Order to

be adequately protective of the public interest, and other good cause appearing;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 3rd DAY OF January, 2008

ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of professional counseling, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(n) and N.J.S.A. 45:8B-39(a).


2. Respondent is reprimanded for aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of professional counseling, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(n) and N.J.S.A. 45:8B-39(a).

3. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00). Payment shall be by certified check or money order, payable to the "State of New Jersey" and sent to Elaine DeMars, Executive Director, Professional Counselor Examiners Committee, P.O. Box 45044, Newark, New Jersey 07101. The civil penalty shall be paid simultaneously with the signing of the within order. Providing that respondent complies with the terms of the Consent Order and provides documentation to the Executive Director, Elaine DeMars within thirty (30) days that all the counselors that she is currently supervising are licensed, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of the civil penalty shall be stayed.

4. Failure to remit payment as required by this Consent Order


will result in the filing of a Certificate of Debt and such other proceedings as are permitted by law.


