**ORDER GRANTING UNRESTRICTED
LICENSURE**

This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that on or about September 27, 2005, in the Superior Court of the State of Delaware, Sussex County, Dr. Mehdi entered a plea of nolo contendere to the charge of offensive touching, in violation of 11 Del.C. §601(a)(1), in that he engaged in an act of offensive touching regarding a female patient. Dr. Mehdi was placed on probation for one year. On or about July 18, 2006 the Delaware Board of Medical Practice adopted the terms of a consent order signed by Dr. Mehdi. The consent order found that Dr. Mehdi had been convicted of a crime

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substantially related to the practice of medicine. Dr. Mehdi agreed to have his Delaware medical license placed on probation, concurrent with the period of probation that he was serving as a result of the criminal conviction. On June 14, 2007, Dr. Mehdi entered into a Consent Order with the state of New Jersey by which he agreed that his license would be suspended until such time that he can demonstrate that he has satisfied all the terms and conditions of his criminal probation and show proof that he has been released from probation by the Delaware Board of Medical Practice and holds an active unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Delaware. Dr. Mehdi also agreed that he would appear before a Committee of the Board prior to his New Jersey medical license being reinstated.

In October of 2007 respondent appeared before the Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board and petitioned for unrestricted licensure. The Board is satisfied that the respondent has complied with the prior consent order. Dr. Mehdi submitted documentation demonstrating satisfaction of all requirements of the Delaware order including: (1) copy of an early probation termination letter from the Superior Court of Delaware, (2) copy of the letter terminating probation from the Delaware board of Medical Practice, (3) copy of an unrestricted Delaware medical license, (4) copy of twelve (12) CME credits in professional boundaries, ethics and professional sexual misconduct and (5) the reports of

~~professional counseling and evaluation by three psychologists. The~~
Board is satisfied that the respondent has complied with the prior consent order.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ON THIS 17th DAY OF January 2008

ORDERED:

1. Respondent Mohammad Mehdi, M.D. is hereby granted unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.
