This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that Kent Ellis, M.D. applied for an unrestricted medical license following an Order of Restricted Licensure filed September 12, 2001.

In October 2007 Dr. Ellis appeared before the Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board and petitioned for unrestricted licensure with the full support of the Physician's Assistance Program. The Board is satisfied that Dr. Ellis has fully complied with the prior Consent Order, participated appropriately in urine testing, attendance at Alcoholics Anonymous meetings, face-to-face follow up with the Physician's Assistance Program

and group aftercare and appears to have been in stable recovery for over six years.


The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,
