This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) upon receipt of Dr. Bursztyn's request for unrestricted licensure. By way of a Consent Order filed in New Jersey on May 10, 2007, Dr. Bursztyn was suspended from the practice of medicine in New Jersey based upon his willfully making false representations on his initial licensure application in Maryland (licensure was denied in Maryland) and thereafter being suspended for one year in New York on or about July 10, 2006 based upon the false representations made in Maryland. Dr. Bursztyn's suspension in New Jersey was retroactive to the suspension in New York that began on November 2, 2006. The New Jersey Consent Order filed on May 10, 2007,

required Dr. Bursztyn prior to any application for reinstatement of his medical license in New Jersey, to submit documentation to the Board proving he has fully complied with the New York Order filed on or about July 10, 2006. By way of correspondence dated December 7, 2007 to the Board, Dr. Bursztyn submitted a letter from the State of New York Department of Health stating that he has fulfilled all of the requirements of his Order with New York.


The Board having reviewed Dr. Bursztyn's request for reinstatement of his license, finding that Dr. Bursztyn has satisfied the one year suspension of his license in New Jersey and has fully complied with New York's Order dated on or about July 10, 2006, and the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare;

IT IS, therefore, on this 15th day of May, 2008, ORDERED THAT:

1. Enrique M. Bursztyn, M.D., is hereby granted an unrestricted licence to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.
