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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of
Medical Examiners ("the Board") upon receipt of a petition for
restoration of unrestricted licensure filed on behalf of Ronaldo C.
DeGuzman, D.O., a licensee of the Board.

The record in this matter reflects the following: Dr.
DeGuzman has been practicing medicine in New Jersey pursuant to a
Consent Order granting restricted licensure, filed with the Board
on November 2, 2006 ("Consent Order"). Pursuant to the Consent
Order, Dr. DeGuzman was required, among other things, to have a
chaperone present whenever he treated female patients, for a
minimum period of one year. After the expiration of one year, Dr.
DeGuzman requested that the chaperone requirement be lifted. Dr.

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DeGuzman provided the Board with evidence that he has complied with the chaperone requirement and that his chaperones have not observed him engage in any inappropriate conduct toward female patients. Dr. DeGuzman has also provided a report of evaluation from a psychiatrist and one from a psychologist stating that Dr. DeGuzman does not pose any danger to his patients or the public.

Based upon the Board's assessment of the information provided, the Board is satisfied that the removal of the chaperone requirement and the granting of unrestricted licensure to Dr. DeGuzman is consistent with the public health, safety and welfare.

For the reasons set forth herein and the Board having determined that the within is adequately protective of the public, and with all other requirements of the Consent Order having been met, and for other good cause shown:

It is therefore on this 13 day of June , 2008,

ORDERED THAT

1. Ronaldo C. DeGuzman, D.O. is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey and the chaperone requirement set forth in the November 2, 2006 Consent Order is hereby terminated.
