This matter was opened to the State Board of Medical Examiner upon receipt of information that Claus Speth, M.D. had applied for an unrestricted medical license. On December 5, 1997, Dr. Speth was convicted of witness tampering. Pursuant to an interim consent order dated June 10th, 1998, Dr. Speth voluntarily surrendered his license to practice medicine in the State of New Jersey pending the outcome of his appeal of the criminal conviction. Pursuant to a Consent Order on January 12th, 2006, Dr. Speth's license was reinstated and he agreed to

a seven and a half year period of retroactive active suspension, a two year period of probation (ending January 2008), payment of a penalty and costs and limitation of practice solely to forensic medicine until further order of the Board.

Dr. Speth appeared and testified before a committee of the Board on May 28, 2008 in support of his application for unrestricted licensure. Dr. Speth testified, and the Board finds, that he has complied with all terms of probation in the 2006 Consent Order and that he has paid all penalties and costs.

The Board having considered Dr. Speth's testimony and all relevant documentation submitted and finding the within Order adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,


IT IS on this 22 day of July, 2008
