

and had allegedly been filling unauthorized prescriptions for Ibuprofen, a Prescription Legend Drug, Ambien, a Schedule IV Controlled Dangerous Substance, Guaifenesin, a Prescription Legend Drug, Rondec, a Prescription Legend Drug, Pepcid, a Prescription Legend Drug, Zyrtec, a Prescription Legend Drug and Zithromax, a Prescription Legend Drug for herself. Respondent was charged with Obtaining Prescription Medications by Fraud, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-13 and Conspiracy to Obtain Prescription Medications by Fraud, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2(A). Respondent had entered a plea of Conspiracy to Obtain Controlled Substances by Fraud in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1 and 2C:35-13 in connection with the prescriptions for B.W. Having successfully completed her period of criminal probation, respondent has now made re-application for the reinstatement of her pharmacy license.

In support of her application, respondent, on July 9, 2008, testified under oath before the Board and expressed her remorse for exercising such poor judgment. She submitted that she went through a period of extreme stress that "manifested itself in temporary loss of good judgment." She concluded, however, that she has recovered well from all events and in her opinion, she is able to function properly as a licensed pharmacist.

Respondent, being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and agreeing to waive any right to same, and the Board having determined that

this Order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and all parties agreeing to the terms of this Order;

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 10th day of SEPTEMBER, 2008,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby reinstated subject to the condition set forth in this Order.

2. Respondent shall pay all reinstatement fees and submit proof of the necessary continuing education credits and successfully complete all application requirements including a Criminal History Background Check prior to her license being reinstated.

3. This Order is effective upon its filing date with the Board of Pharmacy.
