This matter was presented to the State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") by request of Henry Miles Sherman, M.D. ("Dr. Sherman"), of Morristown, New Jersey, seeking modification of license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey. Dr. Sherman is currently subject to an Order Granting Limited Reinstatement of Licensure filed November 8, 2007, allowing his limited reinstatement following a period of revocation that began by Board Order effective June 7, 1996.

By the terms of the Order of November 8, 2007, Dr. Sherman is limited to practicing, without remuneration or financial benefit, at a clinic providing free medical services, and may only prescribe medications to the clinic's patients and only on New Jersey prescription blanks of the clinic. Dr. Sherman indicated to the Board that he would practice at Eva's Village Primary Care Clinic in Paterson, New Jersey.

By letter dated April 10, 2008, Dr. Sherman petitioned the Board for permission to practice under the same restrictions at a second clinic, "Orange Primary Care Center/Suburban Medical Associates" in Orange, New Jersey. In support of his petition, Dr. Sherman submitted a

letter from William A. DiGiacomo, M.D., the medical director of Suburban Medical Associates.

A Committee of the Board has considered the matter and Dr. DiGiacomo has confirmed that Suburban Medical Associates is a clinic that provides free medical services and is a separate office from any other private for-profit medical office; that he is aware of Dr. Sherman's practice restrictions; and that should Dr. Sherman be allowed to join the clinic, Suburban Medical Associates will be in compliance with state and federal regulations governing prescriber and healthcare facility identification numbers on prescription blanks. The Board also received a letter from Robert Collin, M.D., medical director of Eva's Village, attesting to Dr. Sherman's compliance with his practice restrictions. Finally, the Board received from Dr. Sherman proof of current malpractice insurance coverage pursuant to the mandatory coverage requirement set forth in N.J.S.A. 45:9-19.17.

The Board having been satisfied that Dr. Sherman is in compliance with the terms of his limited licensure and finding the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,

IT IS, ON THIS 22nd DAY OF September 2008

ORDERED:

1. All provisions of the Board's Order of November 8, 2007, remain in force and effect.
2. Dr. Sherman shall practice medicine only at Eva's Village Primary Care Clinic, Paterson, New Jersey, and Suburban Medical Associates, Orange, New Jersey, and shall do so only in conformity with the Board's Order of November 8, 2007.
3. Any practice beyond the limitations set forth above shall be deemed a violation of this present Order, which will subject Dr. Sherman to an application for an immediate suspension of his licensure privileges.
4. Dr. Sherman shall have the right to apply for removal of the suspension on ten days notice but, in such event, shall be limited to a showing that information submitted was false.
