CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of information that Richard E. Glass, D.C. (hereinafter "Respondent") submitted an insurance claim for payment, knowing that the statement of claim contained false information material to the claim. Specifically, Respondent stipulated the aforesaid violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq. in a civil proceeding brought against him by the Office of Insurance Fraud Prosecutor (Copy of the stipulation made a part hereof, and attached hereto as "Exhibit A."). Respondent consented to an *Order for the Entry of Judgment by Consent* in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division, Union County, Docket. No. UNN-L-3431-07, which order entered judgment against him in the amount of \$5,054.95, comprised of \$3,500.00 civil penalty to be paid to the Commissioner of the

New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, and \$1,500.00 attorney fees and \$54.95 costs to be paid to the State of New Jersey. (Copy of Judgment made a part hereof, and attached hereto as "Exhibit B.")

Having reviewed these documents, it appears to the Board that they establish the basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(k), in that Respondent has admitted violating a provision of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; has been adjudicated as having committed the said violation in civil proceedings; and has been the subject of a final order entered in those civil proceedings imposing civil penalties under the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act.

It appearing that Respondent desires to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings, and for good cause shown:

IT IS ON THIS 27th DAY OF OCTOBER, 2008


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent is hereby reprimanded for, and shall cease and desist from any further violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act.
2. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended for a period of six (6) months, which shall be stayed and become a period of probation. Such stayed period of suspension shall be activated upon a showing of Respondent's non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions set forth herein.
3. During the period of stayed suspension, Respondent shall successfully complete and unconditionally pass the ProBE (Professional Problem Based Ethics) course offered by The Ethics Group, 89 Summit Avenue, Suite 185, Summit, New Jersey 07901, or the PRIME (Professional Renewal in Medicine through Ethics) course offered by the Center for Continuing Education in the Health Professions at UMDNJ-Robert Wood Johnson Medical School, 97 Paterson


Street, Room 124, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08903. Documentation of the full and successful completion of the course shall be provided to the Board within thirty (30) days of his successful completion of the course.

4. The Directives of the Board applicable to any Chiropractic Board licensee who is suspended, revoked or whose surrender of licensure has been accepted are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, whether or not they are attached hereto.



The claim in this action having been settled and resolved by the parties, Plaintiff, State of New Jersey - Office of the Insurance Fraud Prosecutor, and defendant, Richard E. Glass, D.C.;

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties hereto that upon filing of this Stipulation of Settlement defendant acknowledges the jurisdiction of this Court and accepts service of any Complaint in this matter; and,

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties hereto that the defendant submitted an insurance claim for payment knowing that the statement contained false information material to the claim; and

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED that this conduct constitutes a violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud

Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1, et seq., and, that any future violation of the Act shall be considered a subsequent violation; and,

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED that the defendant shall pay to the Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance a civil penalty, in the amount of \$3,500.00, and shall pay attorney fees in the amount of \$1,500.00 and costs in the amount of \$54.95 to the State of New Jersey, for a total amount of \$5,054.95 to be satisfied upon the following terms and conditions:

1. That on or before February 29, 2008, the defendant shall mail to the attorney for the State of New Jersey an initial payment by check in the amount of \$224.95, payable to "Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance."

2. Beginning on April 1, 2008, and on the first of each month thereafter, the defendant shall make twenty-three monthly installment payments of \$210.00, each payable to "Commissioner, Department of Banking and Insurance," until his indebtedness is paid in full.

3. Each monthly payment of \$210.00 shall be mailed to: Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, P.O. Box 324, Trenton, NJ 08625.

4. "OIFP #00-09919-04" shall appear on all checks and communications in this regard.

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that default shall be deemed to have occurred if any payment is not received within ten (10) days of the date the payment is due; whereupon the Plaintiff,

without further notice to the defendant, may commence collection proceedings pursuant to the Order for Entry of Judgment by Consent signed in conjunction with this Stipulation of Settlement or may undertake such other judicial process as may be appropriate; and,

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-10(c), a copy of this Stipulation of Settlement shall be provided to the appropriate licensing authorities. This ~~Stipulation of Settlement may be used against defendant~~ Richard E. Glass, D.C. in any civil or administrative proceeding related to a violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1, et seq., including a license suspension or revocation proceeding; and,

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that the penalties of this Stipulation of Settlement are imposed pursuant to the police powers of the State of New Jersey for the enforcement of the law and protection of the public health, safety and welfare, and are not intended to constitute debts which may be limited or discharged in a bankruptcy proceeding.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within 7 days from the date thereof.




