This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that on August 25, 2006, Robert George Ranelle, D.O. (hereinafter "respondent") entered into an Agreed Order with the Texas Medical Board. The Agreed Order provided that respondent failed to meet the standard of care and failed to maintain adequate medical records for three patients. Pursuant to a Consent Order filed with the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners on April 19, 2007, respondent acknowledged the Agreed Order filed with the Texas Medical Board and consented to appear before the Board or a Committee thereof prior to resuming practice in New Jersey to demonstrate fitness to practice in New Jersey and full compliance with the Agreed Order of the Texas Medical Board.

CERTIFIED TRUE COPY

On September 24, 2008 Dr. Ranelle appeared pro se before a Committee of the Board and petitioned for an unrestricted licensure. Dr. Ranelle testified and presented documents regarding his compliance with the terms of the Texas Order and his fitness to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey. The Board is satisfied that Dr. Ranelle is fit to practice and is complying with the Texas Medical Board.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,


