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: Consent Order  
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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that respondent pleaded guilty to one count of Uttering a Forged Instrument, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(3), in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Morris County. Specifically, respondent presented to CVS Pharmacy a prescription for a quantity of Hydrocodone Compound Syrup, a controlled dangerous substance, knowing that the prescription was not written, signed or authorized by the doctor. On or about October 24, 2008 respondent was sentenced to a three year period of probation with the condition that he consent to a suspension of his license to practice pharmacy for a period of three years. The parties wishing to avoid formal proceedings before the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy, and respondent having waived any right to a hearing in this matter and the Board having considered the underlying offense to be a crime reflecting adversely on

the practice of pharmacy, and one of moral turpitude, and thus violative of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f), and for good cause shown,

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 10<sup>th</sup> DAY OF DEC, 2008,

**ORDERED AND AGREED:**

1. Respondent's license to practice pharmacy is hereby revoked with no right to request reinstatement for three (3) years from the date of entry of this Order.
2. Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with patients, and he is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy.
3. Respondent shall, by execution of the within Order, authorize the surrender of his original wall certificate, his wallet certificate, and his most recent renewal card of his license to an authorized representative of the Board of Pharmacy. All license certificates and renewals shall be surrendered contemporaneously with the entry of this Order.
