CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) upon receipt of information that C. Samuel Vergheese (Respondent) was holding himself out as a medical doctor and as practicing alternative medicine in the State of New Jersey, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9-6 as he does not hold a license for the practice of medicine.

The Board having found the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare, and C. Samuel Vergheese waiving any right to a hearing in this matter, submitting himself to the jurisdiction of the Board, and being desirous of resolving this matter without the need for further formal proceedings,

ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from engaging in conduct that may be construed by a reasonable person as holding himself out to the public as a medical doctor and/or a doctor of alternative medicine as defined by N.J.S.A. 45:9-5.1.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from using the initials "M.D." and/or "M.D. (A.M.)" after his name.

3. Respondent shall not represent he has credentials, background, experience or expertise in the fields of medicine or alternative medicine to any New Jersey consumers in connection with any offer to provide, or in the course of any act that may be construed by a reasonable person as the provision of health care.

4. Respondent agrees that if he violates any provision of this Consent Order the Board may file an injunctive action against Respondent in the Superior Court of New Jersey, seeking monetary penalties and injunctive relief against Respondent, and that this order shall serve as an acknowledgment by Respondent that he does not hold a license to practice medicine, surgery or alternative medicine, and may not offer to practice or so practice in New Jersey.
