CONSENT ORDER  
OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of an application for reinstatement of the license of Michael Baer (hereinafter "Respondent") to practice chiropractic in New Jersey. On January 24, 2005, Respondent's license to practice chiropractic was suspended for five years, the first two years of which would be an active suspension commencing as of January 16, 2004, and the final three years of which were stayed to become a period of probation. The Board's action was based upon Respondent's criminal convictions for health care claims fraud and the use of a runner.

Having reviewed the entire record, including the testimony of Respondent before the Board on January 22, 2009, it appears to the Board that Respondent's license may be reinstated consistent with the public health, safety and welfare, with certain conditions. Respondent having agreed to said conditions being placed upon the reinstatement of his license to probationary status, and for good cause shown:



HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:


1. Respondent shall comply with all applicable requirements for reinstatement of his license pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:44E-1A.4, including but not limited to the payment of all applicable fees.
2. Respondent shall pay all civil penalties assessed on January 24, 2005 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22 in the total amount of \$7,500.00. An initial payment in the amount of \$1,500.00 shall be submitted no later than 30 days from the entry of this Consent Order. Thereafter, Respondent shall make twelve monthly payments of \$500.00 per payment. The first payment shall be due by April 1, 2009, and subsequent payments shall continue to be due by the first of each succeeding month until all twelve payments are completed. In the event that Respondent does not make a timely payment, the full balance will immediately become due. All payments shall be by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be sent to Jonathan Eisenmenger, Executive Director, Board of Chiropractic Examiners, P. O. Box 45004, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

3. Respondent's license may be suspended or revoked upon a showing of his non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions set forth herein.
