**CONSENT ORDER OF  
OF REINSTATEMENT**

This matter was most recently opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) upon receipt of a request from Farhad Mohebban, M.D., (Respondent), through his counsel Angela M. Ribaldo, Esq., seeking to reinstate his medical license which was revoked by way of a Final Order of Discipline dated November 26, 2002. A Provisional Order of Discipline was filed on February 4, 2002, after the Board received information that the New York State Board for Professional Medical Conduct (NY Board) and Respondent entered into a Consent Agreement and Order where he was subject to five years probation and a \$5,000.00 fine based on a federal conviction. The federal conviction was based upon the fact that Respondent was found guilty of Medicare Kickback Conspiracy (18 U.S.C. Section 371) and three counts of Medicare Kickbacks (42 U.S.C. Section 1320 a - 7b(b)(1)) in the United States District Court, Southern District of New

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York, on or about January 6, 1999. As a result of the federal conviction, Respondent was sentenced to pay a \$20,000.00 fine and ordered to serve two years of probation, including six months of home confinement. Respondent failed to respond to the Provisional Order of Discipline, therefore, the Board entered a Final Order of Discipline revoking Respondent's license to practice medicine in New Jersey on November 2, 2002.

Respondent and his counsel appeared before a committee of the Board on July 16, 2008. Respondent testified and demonstrated to the committee that he has satisfied all of the sentencing terms from his federal conviction, he has had an active unrestricted medical license in New York since November 30, 2007 and has been working in the field of cosmetic and aesthetic medicine since 2002. Respondent now seeks leave to reinstate his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey. The Board finding that Respondent appeared to be remorseful regarding his previous conduct which led to his federal conviction, satisfied the sentencing terms of his federal conviction, has an unrestricted license to practice medicine in New York and that the Board finds the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,

IT IS THEREFORE on this 18 day of February, 2009, ORDERED:

I. Farhad Mohebban, M.D. is hereby granted a license to practice medicine in New Jersey on the following terms and conditions:

A) Prior to Respondent being reinstated to practice medicine in New Jersey, Respondent shall successfully complete a Board pre-approved ethics course within six (6) months from the date of the entry of this Order. ("Successfully complete" means that Respondent attends all sessions of the course, fully participates in the course, and receives a final evaluation of an unconditional pass.). Prior to Respondent being reinstated to practice medicine in New Jersey,


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Respondent shall submit to the Director of Medical Education or to the Executive Director of the Medical Board, written verification that he satisfactorily completed the ethics course.

B) Prior to Respondent being reinstated to practice medicine in New Jersey, Respondent shall successfully complete a Board pre-approved SPEX (Special Purpose Examination) exam ~~in internal medicine~~ within six (6) months from the date of the entry of this Order. Prior to Respondent being reinstated to practice medicine in New Jersey, Respondent shall submit to the Director of Medical Education or to the Executive Medical Director of the Board, written verification that he satisfactorily completed the SPEX exam in internal medicine.


