This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Jinoos Kazemi, D.D.S. ("respondent"), License No. 22 DI 02056300, was initially licensed to practice dentistry in this State on November 16, 1998.
2. Respondent did not renew her license to practice dentistry prior to its expiration on October 31, 2007, and has not renewed or attempted to renew her license since that time.
3. Respondent has failed to respond to correspondence sent from the Board to her address of record in January and March 2008.

4. Respondent's failure to renew her license for the biennial registration period November 1, 2007 through October 31, 2009, resulted in a lapsed license status and provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 15th day of April, 2009,


ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing. Any practice of dentistry during the period in which she does not hold an active license shall be deemed the unlicensed practice of dentistry and shall subject respondent to disciplinary action.

2. In the event that respondent seeks reinstatement of her New Jersey license, she shall appear before the Board or a committee of the Board to establish that she is fit to practice dentistry in this State and to provide information relevant to the Board's inquiry. The Board reserves the right to deny reinstatement, take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey.
