This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Azam Z. Sadatrafiel, D.M.D. (respondent), License No. 22 DI 02041100, was initially licensed to practice dentistry in this State on August 10, 1998.
2. Respondent did not renew his license to practice dentistry prior to its expiration on October 31, 2001, and has not renewed or attempted to renew his license since that time.
3. Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New York was suspended March 21, 2006, by a Consent Order issued by the New York State Education

Department Office of Professional Discipline, State Board of Dentistry, for engaging in professional misconduct.

4. Respondent's failure to renew his license for the biennial registration period November 1, 2001 through October 31, 2003, or at any time since then, has resulted in a lapsed license status and provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 23rd day of April, 2009,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing. Any practice of dentistry during the period in which he does not hold an active license shall be deemed the unlicensed practice of dentistry and shall subject respondent to disciplinary action.

2. In the event that respondent seeks reinstatement of his New Jersey license, he shall appear before the Board or a committee of the Board to establish that he is fit to practice dentistry in this State and to provide information relevant to the Board's inquiry, including the 2006 facts underlying the action taken by the State of New York. The Board reserves the right to deny reinstatement, take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey.
