This matter was opened before the Alcohol and Drug Counselor Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners (hereinafter "the Committee") upon review of information that respondent was engaging in the practice of alcohol and drug counseling and is not licensed or certified by the Committee or any other mental health licensing Board to engage in mental health counseling, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:2D-8.

Mr. Bradley responded to a Demand for Statement Under Oath, dated April 8, 2009 and admitted that he engaged in alcohol and drug counseling in a for-profit private practice, Final Stop Family Services,

76 South Orange, New Jersey 07079, under the supervision of B'Nay James, LMFT since March 2007. Respondent also submitted a resume with his name followed by the credential "CCDC," (Certified Chemical Dependency Counselor) a credential not recognized in the State of New Jersey.

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Committee finding the Consent Order to be adequately protective of the public interest, and other good cause appearing;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 14th DAY OF May, 2009

ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from engaging in, advertising or holding himself out as qualified to practice any mental health counseling, including but not limited to alcohol and drug counseling, marriage and family therapy, social work and/or psychotherapy unless and until he is licensed or certified by the Committee or otherwise appropriately licensed in the State of New Jersey to provide mental health counseling services.


2. Respondent shall cease and desist holding himself out in New Jersey as a "CCDC" or as a Certified Chemical Dependency Counselor or any other credential indicating competency to provide counseling services not recognized in the State of New Jersey.

3. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the "State of New Jersey" and sent to Elaine DeMars, Executive Director, Professional Counselor Examiners Committee, P.O. Box 45044, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07101.


The civil penalty shall be paid contemporaneously with the signing of the Consent Order.

4. Failure to remit payment as required by this Order will result in the filing of a Certificate of Debt and such other proceedings as are permitted by law.


