ORDER OF SUMMARY
SUSPENSION

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of information revealing the following:

1. Respondent, Ronald Rahman, M.D., is the holder of License No. 25MA03920400 and was licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey on July 1, 1981 and, thereafter, permitted that license to lapse on June 30, 2005.

2. On or about June 11, 2009, Respondent was arrested in Camden County, New Jersey, on allegations of illegal prescription drug distribution. More specifically, Respondent is alleged to have issued fraudulent prescriptions to drug-seeking individuals in New Jersey, while using prescription blanks bearing a fraudulent New York address.

3. Respondent's failure to submit his biennial renewal in New Jersey in 2005 has resulted in a lapsed license status and the automatic suspension of Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey without a hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 25TH day of JUNE 2009,


ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey is suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing, *nunc pro tunc* to July 30, 2005.

2. In the event that Respondent seeks reinstatement of his New Jersey license at any time in the future, then this Order shall require Respondent to appear before a Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners to establish that he is fit to practice medicine in New Jersey and provide information concerning the criminal investigation in Camden County, New Jersey. Additionally, the Board reserves the right to take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of New Jersey.
