ORDER REINSTATING LICENSE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon application by Nicholas G. Rosania, D.C., (hereinafter "Respondent") for reinstatement of his license to engage in the active practice of chiropractic in this State. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic was suspended by the Board on June 19, 2003, based upon his conviction of the crimes of Conspiracy, Official Misconduct, and Bribery in Official Matters. On June 25, 2009, Respondent appeared before the Board accompanied by counsel, Jeffrey B. Randolph, Esq., to provide testimony regarding his fitness to resume practice.


Having reviewed the entire record, including the testimony of Respondent, it appears to the Board that permitting Respondent to return to the active practice of chiropractic in this State is consistent with the health, safety and welfare of the public under certain conditions, and for good cause shown:

IT IS ON THIS 25th DAY OF June, 2009

HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey is reinstated for the current biennial period.
2. Respondent shall take and pass the on-line Jurisprudence examination offered by the Board within six (6) months of the issuance of this Order;
3. Failure to comply with any provisions of this Order may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.
