CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") upon receipt of information revealing that the license of Respondent Constance Willman to practice pharmacy in the State of Nevada was suspended pursuant to NRS 639.211 and 233B.127(3) pending a hearing before the Nevada Board of Pharmacy, based upon Respondent's admission to the hospital for mental illness.

The Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. Respondent is a pharmacist licensed in the State of New Jersey and has been licensed at all times relevant hereto.

2. By Order filed on January 30, 2009, the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy suspended respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of Nevada pending a hearing before the Nevada Board pursuant to NRS 639.211 and 233B.127(3). NRS 639.211 states: "The adjudication of insanity or mental illness, or the voluntary commitment or admission to any hospital for a mental illness of any certificate holder, shall operate as an immediate suspension of the right of the certificate holder to practice pharmacy in this state, and such suspension shall continue until restoration to or declaration of sanity or mental competence."

3. The above disciplinary action taken by the sister State of Nevada provides grounds to take disciplinary action against Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g), in that Respondent has had her authority to engage in the activity regulated by the Board suspended by another state for reasons consistent with N.J.S.A. 45:1-21.

Based upon the above information and findings, and it appearing that Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without formal proceedings, and having waived any right to a hearing, and for other good cause shown.

IT IS ON THIS 19th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2009

ORDERED THAT:

1. The license of Constance Willman, R.P., to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby suspended until such time as she holds an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of Nevada.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from the practice of pharmacy in the State

of New Jersey and shall immediately return her original New Jersey license and current biennial registration to Joanne Boyer, Executive Director, New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy, 124 Halsey Street, 6th Floor P.O. Box 45013, Newark, New Jersey 07101 simultaneously with her signing of this Order.

3. In the event that Respondent seeks reinstatement of her New Jersey pharmacy license at any time in the future, this Order shall require Respondent to appear before the Board, or a Committee thereof, to demonstrate fitness to practice pharmacy and show proof that she holds an active unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada.
