This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Stacy J. Theibault (nee Cupolo) ("respondent"), License No. 22HI004579, was initially licensed to practice dental hygiene in this State on February 1, 1986.
2. Respondent's license was reinstated with restrictions by order of October 25, 2006. That reinstatement followed the respondent's surrender of her license in March 2005 based on her use of controlled dangerous substances that were not prescribed for her.

3. On or about May 23, 2009, in Ocean Township New Jersey, respondent was arrested and charged with possession of a prescription legend drug or stramonium preparation; possession of a controlled dangerous substance or analog; and possession/distribution of a hypodermic needle.

4. Respondent, who had enrolled in the Professional Assistance Program pursuant to the Board's order of October 2006, failed to appear for an appointment at the PAP on June 30, 2009, in violation of that order.

5. Respondent did not renew her license to practice dental hygiene prior to its expiration on December 31, 2009, and has not renewed or attempted to renew her license since that time.

6. Respondent's failure to renew her license for the biennial registration period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011, resulted in a lapsed license status and provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to practice dental hygiene in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2010,

ORDERED THAT:

1. The license of Stacy Theibault to practice dental hygiene in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing. Any practice of dental hygiene during the period in which she does not hold an active license shall be deemed the unlicensed practice of dental hygiene and shall subject respondent to disciplinary action.

2. In the event that respondent seeks reinstatement of her New Jersey license, she shall appear before the Board or a committee of the Board: to establish that she is fit to practice dental hygiene in this State; to provide information concerning the disposition

of criminal charges; and to demonstrate to the Board's satisfaction that she is able to practice dental hygiene with reasonable skill and safety, that she has had sufficient rehabilitation, including a period of sobriety and recovery. The Board reserves the right to deny reinstatement, take disciplinary action, and place restrictions and/or limitations upon respondent's license to practice dental hygiene in the State of New Jersey, based on the information recited in this order or any new information that comes to the attention of the Board .
