CONSENT ORDER

THIS MATTER was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors ("Board") upon application for licensure by Henry W. Hessing ("Respondent") to practice engineering in the State of New Jersey. The Board reviewed information that on or about July 25, 2007 the New York Board of Regents adopted the provisions set forth in an

"Application for Consent Order" ("New York Consent Order") executed by the Respondent at which time his New York license to practice engineering was suspended for one (1) year, but stayed and served as a period of probation. Respondent was also required to pay a \$2,000.00 fine and comply with other terms and conditions. More specifically, the Respondent admitted guilt to one (1) specification of professional misconduct in connection with his failure to prepare and retain for at least six (6) years a written evaluation of the professional services represented by plans signed and sealed by Respondent, and not prepared by him or under his supervision.

As a result of the foregoing, the Board has determined that the New York disciplinary action provides a basis to take disciplinary action against Respondent's New Jersey license to practice engineering pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g) in that his New York license was suspended.

IT NOW APPEARING that the parties wish to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings; and that Respondent meets the requirements to be licensed as a professional engineer in the State of New Jersey; and that the Respondent hereby waives any right to a hearing in this matter; and the Board finding the within Order adequately protects the public's health, safety and welfare; and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 1st day of APRIL, 2010, ORDERED AND AGREED THAT Respondent shall be, and hereby is, granted a license to practice engineering in the State of New Jersey upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent's license to practice engineering in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended for one (1) year, to be stayed in its entirety and served as a period of probation.

2. Respondent agrees that if the Board, upon receipt of reliable information and in its sole discretion, determines during the probationary period that the Respondent has failed to comply with any provision of the New York Consent Order, or is in violation of any of the statutes and/or regulations governing the practice of engineering in the State of New Jersey, then Respondent's New Jersey license to practice engineering shall be automatically and immediately suspended. Within ten (10) days of notification of the suspension, Respondent may seek in writing a hearing before the Board limited to the sole issue of the basis for the automatic suspension.
