This matter was first opened to the State Board of Dentistry ("the Board") upon the application of Michael B. Boyer, D.D.S. for an unrestricted license following a Consent Order filed November 7, 2007 which reinstated Dr. Boyer's license to practice dentistry subject to restrictions.

By way of history, Dr. Boyer previously entered into a Consent Order on May 30, 1991 based on substance abuse impairment. Pursuant to that Order, Dr. Boyer agreed to be monitored by a chemical dependency program including random urine screening, therapy, as well as restrictions on prescription privileges. In July 2004, Dr. Boyer applied for reinstatement of licensure but, by order dated December 16, 2005, the Board denied his reinstatement application as premature and directed that any further petition should not be made sooner than September of 2006 and that he continue monitoring.

Following rehabilitative efforts, on November 7, 2007, Dr. Boyer entered into a Consent Order of Reinstatement subject to

conditions including, continued participation in Professional Assistance Program (PAP) monitoring and treatment.

In support of his current application for an unrestricted license, a request was submitted by Edward Reading, Ph.D., from PAP, requesting an unrestricted license. Dr. Reading attested that Dr. Boyer has had five years of documented recovery, made significant progress in resolving stressful issues, and has completed formal treatment.

The Board is satisfied that Dr. Boyer has complied with the prior consent orders, fulfilled all recovery program requirements, participated appropriately in urine testing, and appears to have been in stable recovery for approximately five years.


The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,
