**FINAL ORDER OF  
DISCIPLINE**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey Cemetery Board following review of information in the Board's files which resulted in the issuance of a Provisional Order of Discipline regarding Odd Fellows Cemetery's failure to file annual Maintenance and Preservation Fund reports for the period January 1, 1991 to December 31, 1998. Odd Fellows Cemetery has responded to the Provisional Order and has submitted for the Board's consideration all outstanding reports. The Board therefore has waived the penalty and makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Odd Fellows Cemetery, holds Certificate of Authority Number 330. Respondent has been a New Jersey Cemetery Company at all times relevant to this matter and is not a municipality.

2. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:27-15, each cemetery company that is not a municipality must file an annual report with the Board showing the extent and augmentation of the Maintenance and Preservation Fund for its fiscal year not later than 120 days after the close of its fiscal year.

3. Odd Fellows Cemetery has now filed the required reports.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The failure to file Annual Reports with the New Jersey Cemetery Board provides grounds for discipline pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (h).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 10 DAY of June, 2010

ORDERED that:

1. Odd Fellows Cemetery shall henceforth cease and desist from failing to file its annual Maintenance and Preservation Fund report within 120 days of the close of its fiscal year.
