This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Gennaro J. Langella, D.M.D. ("respondent"), License No. 22D10149780, was initially licensed to practice dentistry in this State on January 28, 1985.

2. Respondent did not renew his license to practice dentistry prior to its expiration on October 31, 2009.

3. On or about March 1, 2010, respondent submitted an application for reinstatement of his license.

4. Respondent is required to demonstrate completion of continuing dental education for license renewal pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:6-10.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:30-5.1.

5. Respondent's failure to renew his license for the biennial

registration period November 1, 2009 through October 31, 2011, has resulted in lapse license status and provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey without a hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).


ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2010,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing. Any practice of dentistry in this State prior to reinstatement shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice.

2. Respondent license shall be reinstated upon submission of an updated application (if necessary), and proof of completion of 40 credit hours of continuing dental education for the biennial registration period November 1, 2009 through October 31, 2011. The Board reserves the right to take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey based on information that respondent has violated laws and regulations administered by the Board, including but not limited to unlicensed practice, failure to comply with Board directives and matters related to patient care.
