This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry (the "Board") upon receipt of numerous patient complaints alleging that Dr. Aron had performed substandard dentistry, unduly pressured patients for payment, failed to cooperate in the submission to insurance companies of billings for covered procedure, and other violations of the Uniform Enforcement Act and/or Dental Practice Act. Dr. Aron appeared and offered sworn testimony at an inquiry conducted by the Board on July 21, 2010. Thereafter, the Board proposed the within interim resolution which shall remain in place pending further order of the Board and which shall provide the doctor the opportunity to commence the

remediation process.

This settlement is entered into without any admissions by Dr. Aron with regard to the substantive allegations brought to the Board by his patients and without prejudice to the Board's and/or Attorney General's ability to continue to investigate Dr. Aron's conduct and prosecute said conduct in the event that a subsequent settlement is not achieved. Additionally, the parties understand that this is not a disciplinary order. The doctor's cooperation in this interim resolution will be considered a mitigating factor in the event that he is found to have engaged in violations of law. For the reasons expressed herein and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS ON THIS 4th DAY OF August 2010

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. Jeffrey Aron, D.D.S., hereby agrees to cease and desist from the practice of endodontic procedures including root canal therapy and will take all steps necessary to ensure that patients in his practice or those who come to his practice subsequent to this Order are referred to other practitioners for the provision of endodontic treatment and/or root canal therapy.

2. Dr. Aron shall, within five (5) days of the entry of this Order, present himself to the Professional Assistance Program (PAP) of New Jersey to undergo such psychiatric, neuropsychiatric and/or psychological evaluation as the program deems appropriate. In furtherance of those evaluations, the Board and the Attorney

General shall provide the PAP with all pertinent information regarding the investigation of Dr. Aron's conduct and Dr. Aron shall be free to provide any pertinent information in his possession. Dr. Aron agrees to sign a release permitting the PAP and any others involved in his evaluation to communicate with and prepare reports to the Board regarding the evaluations, his compliance and treatment recommendations, if any.

3. Dr. Aron shall immediately take the steps necessary to undergo a skills evaluation to be performed by Oral Health Enrichment of Ohio or an equivalent evaluation through UMDNJ. Such evaluation shall include the Diagnostic Simulated Clinical Exam under the auspices of NERB and shall be completed within 60 days of the within order. Dr. Aron agrees to sign a release permitting the evaluating programs to communicate with and prepare reports to the Board regarding the evaluations, his compliance and remedial education recommendations, if any.

4. Within forty-five (45) days of the date of this Order Dr. Aron shall produce to the Board and the Attorney General a certified financial audit of his practice performed by an accountant licensed to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey.

5. Dr. Aron shall, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of the within Order, provide a list of all dental suppliers from which he has ordered materials during the past twelve months and a list of all dental laboratories with which he has done business

during the last twenty-four months. Together with those lists he shall provide on the letterhead of each entity, a statement of his balance with that entity and the status of his account.

6. Within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order Dr. Aron shall provide a copy of all contracts with DMOs, Self-Insurance Plans and/or Dental Insurance Companies to which he is a signatory.

7. Within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order Dr. Aron shall provide a copy of a current inspection certificate for all radiographic equipment.

8. Within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order Dr. Aron shall provide a copy of a current contract for medical waste disposal together with the schedule of pick-ups in the past twelve months.


