

Administrative Action

PROVISIONAL ORDER
OF DISCIPLINE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("Board") upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and on which the following preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law are made:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jeffery Rivers ("respondent") is a licensed master plumber licensed in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee since June 22, 2007.
2. Respondent is the bona fide representative for Jeff Rivers Plumbing, Heating & HVAC, and has been the bona fide representative since June 22, 2007.
3. The Board received a complaint from consumer C.B. Specifically, it was alleged that between April 3, 2007 to May 23, 2007 respondent, who was unlicensed during this time period, entered into a contract with C.B. to perform plumbing work at 317 Millbrook Avenue, Randolph, New Jersey. Respondent was trading as Jeff Rivers Plumbing, Heating & HVAC during this unlicensed period. Jeff Rivers Plumbing, Heating and HVAC was not a licensed plumbing contracting entity during this time. According to C.B., respondent breached the

contract by failing to complete the work. Additionally, C.B. alleges that respondent caused damage to her home as a result of the work that was performed. According to C.B., she paid respondent a total of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00). In order to obtain the permits necessary to perform the plumbing work, licensed master plumber Paul Rivers (license # 11913), supplied a signed and sealed plumbing permit.

4. A copy of the plumbing permit for 317 Millbrook Avenue, Randolph, New Jersey, dated April 3, 2007, and a copy of the contract between respondent and C.B. was received by the Board. The permit is signed by Paul Rivers in his capacity as bona fide representative of Rivers Plumbing LLC and indicates that Rivers Plumbing is the plumbing contractor performing the plumbing work. The contract contains respondent's signature and indicates that C.B. made three payments of \$5,000.00 to respondent. The date of one payment was May 2, 2007, more than a month before respondent received his plumbing license. (Exhibit A, copy of plumbing permit for 317 Millbrook Avenue, Randolph, New Jersey, dated April 3, 2007, attached and made a part of hereto). (Exhibit B, copy of contract between respondent and C. B., attached and made a part of hereto).

5. Respondent appeared at an investigative inquiry before the Board. While respondent denies having performed any plumbing work for C.B., he did admit to drafting the proposal which included plumbing work. The definition of "Plumbing Contractor", pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:14C-2(h), includes "undertaking or offering to undertake" plumbing for another. Therefore, respondent, by presenting C.G. with the proposal, represented himself as being licensed to perform plumbing services. (Exhibit C, copy of certified transcript of investigative inquiry, pg. 23 & 24, attached and made a part of hereto).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The above preliminary findings of fact provide grounds for disciplinary action against respondent's license, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), in that respondent has engaged in professional or occupational misconduct by engaging in the unlicensed practice of plumbing, in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-1.4(b). Additionally, the above preliminary findings of fact provide grounds for disciplinary action against respondent's license, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b), in that respondent has engaged in the use or employment of dishonesty, fraud, deception, misrepresentation, false promise or false pretense in that he represented himself as a licensed master plumber before he had acquired his license.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 18th day of August 2010, ORDERED that:

1. Respondent is hereby provisionally reprimanded for engaging in professional or occupational misconduct, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), by engaging in the unlicensed practice of plumbing. Additionally, respondent is hereby provisionally reprimanded for engaging in the use or employment of dishonesty, fraud, deception, misrepresentation, false promise or false pretense in that he represented himself as a licensed master plumber before he had acquired his license, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b). Nothing in this provisional order precludes the Board from investigating and/or taking further action against respondent regarding C.B.'s allegations of damage caused to her home by respondent's performance of plumbing services.

2. Respondent is hereby provisionally assessed a civil penalty, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25, in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for engaging in the unlicensed practice of plumbing. Additionally, respondent is hereby provisionally assessed a civil penalty, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25, in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for representing himself as a licensed master plumber before he had acquired his license. Respondent shall remit payment of the civil penalty totaling two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey. The certified check or money order shall be delivered to Executive Director, State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, P.O. Box 45008, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Payment shall be made no later than 15 days after the entry of any Final Order of Discipline in this matter. In the event Respondent fails to make a timely payment, a certificate of debt shall be filed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 45:1-24 and the Board may bring such other proceedings as authorized by law.

3. Respondent shall reimburse consumer C.B. in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00). Payment shall be by a certified check or a money order made payable to C.B. and shall be delivered to Executive Director, State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, P.O. Box 45008, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Payment shall be made no later than 15 days after the entry of any Final Order of Discipline in this matter. In the event Respondent fails to make a timely payment, a certificate of debt shall be filed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 45:1-24 and the Board may bring such other proceedings as authorized by law.

4. The within Order shall be subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry hereof unless respondent requests a modification or dismissal of the above stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by:

a) Submitting a written request for modification or dismissal to, Executive Director, State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, P.O. Box 45008, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

b) Setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed.

c) Submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefore or offered in mitigation of penalty.

5. Any submissions will be reviewed by the Board, and the Board will thereafter determine whether further proceedings are necessary. If no material discrepancies are raised through a supplemental submission during the thirty-day period, or if the Board is not persuaded that submitted materials merit further consideration, a Final Order of Discipline will be entered.

6. In the event that respondent's submissions establish a need for further proceedings, including, but not limited to, an evidentiary hearing, respondent shall be notified with regard thereto. In the event that an evidentiary hearing is ordered, the preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law contained herein may serve as notice of the factual and legal allegations in such proceeding. Additionally, if further proceedings are ordered, the Board may seek to recoup the costs of such proceedings from respondent, in addition to the sanctions and penalties stated above.

I, Jeffrey Rivers, referred to as plumber, agree to do the roughing and finishing plumbing. Roughing consists of: waste lines and water lines to (2) water closets, (1) tub or Jacuzzi, (1) shower, (2) lavatories, (1) kitchen sink, (1) dish washer, (1) laundry tub, (1) washer and installation of tub and shower faucets, (2) outside hose bibs. Roughing of gas lines consists of: (1) dryer, (1) water heater, (1) range and (1) oven.

Finish consists of: all installation of water closets, tub or Jacuzzi, shower, lavatories, dishwasher, kitchen sink, washer and dryer, laundry tub.

Materials included: Wursbo aquapex tubing, all fittings therefore, PVC schedule 40 waster pipe, and all fittings therefore, all shut-off valves required.


