: **UNRESTRICTED LICENSURE**
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This matter most recently was opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of an application for relief from monitoring requirements contained in a Consent Order filed March 24, 2006.

In the March 24, 2006 Order, the Board reinstated Dr. Wreiole's license to practice medicine in New Jersey subject to a variety of conditions based on his history of substance abuse, including his continued participation in a monitoring program overseen by the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey ("PAP-NJ"). The March 24, 2006 Order also required Dr. Wreiole to complete a Board-approved ethics course within six (6) months of the filing of the Order.

CERTIFIED TRUE COPY

This matter has been reopened to the Board based upon its receipt of information attesting to Dr. Wreiole's compliance with the March 24, 2006 Consent Order. In a letter to the Board dated February 9, 2010, as supplemented by a position statement dated April 21, 2010 with attachments, PAP-NJ confirms that Dr. Wreiole has been in ongoing, documented recovery since October 24, 2004. According to PAP-NJ, Dr. Wreiole has remained totally compliant with the mandates of the Board contained in the March 24, 2006 Consent Order as well as with the recommendations of the PAP-NJ, including regularly attending meetings of the support group, Alcoholics Anonymous, and having random urine screens that have been negative for the presence of psychoactive substances, including alcohol. In sum, PAP-NJ represents that Dr. Wreiole has been a "very compliant participant" in its program who seems "truly vested in his recovery" and remains "in very stable recovery."

The Board also has reviewed documentation that Dr. Wreiole successfully completed the PRIM-E ethics course September 8-10, 2006, as also required by the March 24, 2006 Consent Order.

The Board having determined that Dr. Wreiole has been totally compliant with the March 24, 2006 Consent Order and has been in stable, documented recovery for nearly six years, and that the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,

IT IS on this 1ST day of SEPTEMBER, 2010,

ORDERED:

1. August L. Wreiole hereby is granted an unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.
