This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy (Board) upon notice that Dennis Krousos, C.P.A., (Respondent) on or about January 26, 2009, was indicted, in Superior Court of New Jersey, Criminal Division, Monmouth County, and thereafter pled guilty, on or about February 16, 2010, of misconduct by a corporate official, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-9C, a second degree offense. Respondent's sentencing is scheduled for September 10, 2010.

The Board and Respondent seek to resolve this matter on an interim basis recognizing that Respondent agrees not to practice public accountancy in New Jersey until further order of this

Board. The Board reserving the right to take further action, and finding the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public interest and for good cause shown,

IT IS THEREFORE on this 16th day of September, 2010,

ORDERED that:


1. Effective immediately and until further order of the Board, Respondent voluntarily agrees to, and shall cease and desist the practice of public accountancy in the State of New Jersey; and

2. Respondent shall not practice public accountancy in New Jersey under N.J.S.A. 45:2B-50.1 (practice privilege/mobility statute) until such time as his license is fully reinstated without any restrictions in New Jersey; and

3. Respondent hereby acknowledges and agrees that entry of this interim Order shall not in any way preclude any further action against Respondent by the Board or any administrative or law enforcement entity resulting from Respondent's conduct prior to the entry of the within interim Order.
