ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

TO PRACTICE AS A PHYSICIANS'
ASSISTANT IN THE STATE OF
NEW JERSEY

This matter was presented to the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee of New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") by John J. Ryan, PA ("Mr. Ryan") of Glassboro, New Jersey, pursuant to an application for an unrestricted license submitted on his behalf by Louis E. Baxter, M.D., FASAM, Executive Medical Director of the Professional Assistance Program ("PAP").

By way of background, Mr. Ryan entered into a Consent Order which placed conditions on his license on October 25, 2006, based on his writing unauthorized prescriptions for personal use. Mr. Ryan has complied with all of the conditions contained in that order for a period of four years, including consistent participation in the PAP. In granting Mr. Ryan's application for an unrestricted license, the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee considered the strong written recommendation of David Canavan, M.D., Assistant Medical director of the PAP, which recounts that Mr. Ryan has

been free of all non-prescribed drugs since joining the PAP, has faithfully attended and participated in regular meetings as requested, and has maintained complete compliance with all the conditions of the October 25, 2006 Consent Order. In addition, the Committee carefully considered documentation supplied by Mr. Ryan's psychiatrist, Laun Dearfield, D.O., who affirmed his continuing recovery and ongoing commitment to therapy. The Committee also noted Mr. Ryan's completion of four years of restricted practice without incident, as well as his voluntary commitment to maintain monitoring with the PAP in the future.


