This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of a December 10, 2009 petition from Steven Bier, M.D. ("Respondent") requesting that the Board grant respondent an unrestricted medical license.

On or about July 2, 2001, Dr. Bier had entered into a Consent Agreement and Order (New York Order) with the State of New York, Department of Health, State Board of Professional Misconduct ("New York Board") based upon

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Respondent's failure to maintain a record for certain patients which accurately reflected the evaluation and treatment of the patient. The terms of the New York Order were mirrored in a Consent Order filed January 27, 2004 with the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners.

On or about March 22, 2005, Dr. Bier entered into a Modified Consent Order with the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners pursuant to which he agreed to refrain from independently interpreting mammographic examinations in New Jersey until he reestablishes his qualifications pursuant to the Federal Drug Agency rules and regulations. Respondent agreed to a three (3) year practice monitoring period with the Board in the event he began to operate a mammographic facility.

In support of his petition for unrestricted licensure Dr. Bier provided documentation from the Chairman of the Department of Radiology at Newark Beth Israel Medical Center confirming that Dr. Bier has an "exemplary record in both the medical and scholastic aspects of his position" and has surpassed evaluations at the hospital without incident. The Chairman also noted that Respondent is an "excellent radiologist...who has proven to be an asset to the radiology department." Dr. Bier also provided documentation of significant continuing medical education

in the field of radiology and has authored numerous peer reviewed articles on the subject of mammography.

The Board notes that, other than the events of 1998 which gave rise to the current Consent Order, Dr. Bier has no other blemish on his record. Dr. Bier has consistently worked toward improving his practice of medicine and knowledge in the field of interpretive radiology.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,


