INTERIM  
CONSENT ORDER

TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC  
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed, and the parties wishing to resolve this matter without further formal proceedings, hereby stipulate to the following facts.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Jeffrey M. Davis, D.C., is a chiropractic physician in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto.
2. On February 18, 2010, Respondent appeared before the Preliminary Investigation Committee of the Board to provide testimony regarding information disclosed by his criminal history

background check. Additional information was requested by the Committee, and a follow up request dated June 1, 2010, was sent to Respondent in care of his attorney, Mr. Randolph.

3. The additional information requested was as follows:

a. A full and complete report about each of Respondent's arrests, including but not limited to, copies of the police reports, summons, indictments, transcripts of court appearances, judgments and sentencing proceedings; together with updates on the status of any charges that are still pending in any jurisdiction.

b. Legible copies of Respondent's full patient records from his in-patient treatment sessions at the providers named in his testimony before the Preliminary Investigation Committee.

c. The names and addresses of all physicians and therapists who have provided Respondent with treatments and/or therapies in the past year, as well as those who are currently providing treatment.

4. On October 21, 2010, a letter dated October 20, 2010 was received by the Board from Respondent's office manager. The letter advised that Respondent had not been in his office or practicing since June 2010, and was hospitalized for "a medical reason."

It appearing that Respondent desires to resolve this matter on an interim basis without recourse to formal proceedings, and for good cause shown:

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2011

ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent shall cease and desist from practicing chiropractic in the State of New Jersey until further order of the Board.

2. Prior to resuming any practice in New Jersey, Respondent shall provide to the Board all of the documents and information described in paragraph # 3 of the above findings of fact, together with legible copies of Respondent's full patient records from any in-patient or other treatment he has received from June 2010 to date; and shall be required to appear before the


Board (or a committee thereof) to demonstrate his fitness to resume practice. Any practice in this State prior to said appearance shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice. In addition, the Board reserves the right to place restrictions on Respondent's practice should he be permitted to resume practice.

3. The Directives of the Board applicable to any Chiropractic Board licensee whose surrender of licensure has been accepted are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, whether or not they are attached hereto.



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


