This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon the October 2008 application of David I. Kalter, D.D.S. (respondent), seeking to remove restrictions imposed by the Consent Order entered into on June 9, 2008.

Based upon that demonstration, the Board has determined that removal of restrictions on respondent's license is consistent with the public health, safety and welfare.
