

Administrative Action

ORDER OF SUMMARY
SUSPENSION

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("the Board") upon receipt of information revealing the following:

1. Respondent, Harry J. Cassinelli, is the holder of License No. 36BI00751400 and was licensed to engage in the plumbing business in the State of New Jersey from November 1, 1985 until June 30, 2009 after which time respondent permitted his license to lapse.
2. On May 28, 2009, respondent appeared before the Board for

an investigative inquiry concerning the receipt of four (4) consumer complaints. Respondent was represented by Gabrielle Gallagher, Esq. At the conclusion of the inquiry, the Board instructed respondent and counsel to provide additional information related to the consumer complaints. Respondent failed to provide the documentation. Despite subsequent contacts to representatives of respondent, respondent has still failed to provide the requested information.

3. Respondent's failure to submit his biennial renewal in 2009, resulting in a lapsed license status, provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to engage in the plumbing business, in the State of New Jersey, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 24 day of FEB, 2011,
ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to engage in the plumbing business, in the State of New Jersey, shall be and hereby is suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing.

2. Prior to the Board entertaining any petition for reinstatement of his license to engage in the Plumbing Business, respondent shall be required to appear before the Board to demonstrate fitness to resume practice and to provide the requested information concerning the consumer complaints. Further, respondent shall satisfy any requirements for reinstatement of licensees with

lapsed licenses pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b). Any practice in this State prior to said appearance shall constitute grounds for the charge of unlicensed practice. Additionally, the Board specifically reserves the right to bring further proceedings with regard to the consumer complaints received by the Board. Finally, the Board reserves the right to place restrictions on respondent's practice should his license be reinstated.
