The New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Respondent, Richard S. Bradway, D.D.S., is the holder of license No. 22DI00920900 and was initially licensed to practice as a dentist in the State of New Jersey on July 21, 1971. Upon submission of biennial renewal applications, Respondent was continually licensed from 1971 until October 31, 2003. However, respondent did not submit a biennial renewal application or renew his license to practice dentistry prior to its expiration on October 31, 2003, and has not renewed it since that time.

2. On or about July 1, 2010, respondent submitted an application for reinstatement of his license, in which he admitted

continuing to practice dentistry after his license expired November 1, 2003.

3. Respondent's failure to renew his license for the biennial registration period November 1, 2003 through the present, ~~resulted in a lapsed license status and provides grounds to automatically suspend respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).~~

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 11th day of March, 2011,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice Dentistry in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended nunc pro tunc by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing. Any practice of dentistry during the period in which he did not hold an active license shall be deemed the unlicensed practice of dentistry and shall subject respondent to disciplinary action.

2. Prior to consideration of his application for reinstatement of his New Jersey license, respondent shall submit an updated application, proof of completion of a minimum of 80 credit hours of continuing dental education for the biennial registration periods November 1, 2007 through October 31, 2011 and shall take and successfully pass the North East Regional Board examination(NERB) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(d).

3. Nothing in this order shall be deemed to preclude the Board from taking disciplinary action if respondent's license is reinstated, including imposing sanctions, penalties and placing

limits or conditions on respondent's license to practice Dentistry
in the State of New Jersey.
