

THIS MATTER having been opened to the New Jersey State Board of Architects upon receipt of information that Respondent, Kevin White, offered and/or engaged in the unlicensed practice of architecture in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:3-10 and N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2; and the Board having issued a Uniform Penalty Letter notifying Respondent of these charges on February 2, 2011 and on which the following findings of fact and conclusions of law are made;

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

More specifically, the Board finds that on or about April 24, 2009 Respondent entered into a "Proposal/Contract for Architectural Services" ("Proposal") with Nicaury Miller in connection with property located in Union, New Jersey. Respondent was identified as the architect of record and signed the Proposal, although he is not a New Jersey licensed architect. Further, in the Proposal Respondent offered to provide architectural design services and, in fact, prepared architectural documents, although he is not a New Jersey licensed architect.

Accordingly, Respondent's use of the title "architect"; signing of the Proposal as the architect; offering and providing architectural design services; and preparation of architectural documents, each constitute the unlicensed practice of architecture in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:3-10 and N.J.A.C. 13:27-3.2.

DISCUSSION ON FINALIZATION

Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, a Uniform Penalty Letter was entered by this Board on February 2, 2011 and served upon Respondent by regular and certified mail. The Uniform Penalty Letter was subject to finalization on the 30th business day following entry unless Respondent completed, signed and returned the attached Acknowledgment. If Respondent failed to complete, sign and return the Acknowledgment, then the Uniform Penalty Letter provided that the charges set forth therein shall be deemed uncontested and a default entered against him.

As of the entry of this Final Order, Respondent has failed to complete, sign and return the Acknowledgment and, therefore, the Board finds that he is in default and that the charges set forth in the Uniform Penalty Letter are deemed uncontested. Accordingly, upon review of this matter, the Board has determined that further proceedings are unnecessary and enters this Final Order in accordance with the Uniform Penalty Letter.


ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ON THIS 25 day of March, 2011, ORDERED that:

1. Respondent shall immediately CEASE AND DESIST from the unlicensed practice of architecture as set forth herein above;
2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$5,000.00) within ten (10) days of the entry of this Final Order by certified

check or money order made payable to the "State of New Jersey" and forwarded to the State Board of Architects, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101. If Respondent fails to pay the civil penalty within the stated time period, then a Certificate of Debt shall be issued; and

3. Respondent shall pay restitution in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,500.00) within ten (10) days of the entry of this Final Order by certified check or money order made payable to the "State of New Jersey" and forwarded to the State Board of Architects, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101. If Respondent fails to pay the restitution within the stated time period, then a Certificate of Debt shall be issued
