**THIS MATTER** was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") upon receipt of information that the Englewood Department of Public Works found numerous syringes mixed with household garbage in a torn garbage bag at 96 Charles Street in Englewood, New Jersey and that respondent appeared to be engaging in the practice of medicine.

Respondent was arrested on June 14, 2007 by the Englewood Police Department for Unlicensed Practice of Medicine. In a statement to police on June 14, 2007, respondent admitted that she performed procedures that included multiple injections of artichoke

extract and procaine using hypodermic needles on multiple persons in the garage located at 96 Charles Street in Englewood, New Jersey.

Respondent admits that she is not licensed by the State of New Jersey to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery. Respondent neither admits nor denies that she offered to engage in, held herself out as eligible to engage in, or engaged in the practice of medicine and surgery, but acknowledges that such activities may only be performed by persons licensed by the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners.

The parties desiring to resolve this matter without the need for further proceedings and the Board finding that the within Consent Order is adequately protective of the public interest, and for good cause shown,

**ORDERED AND AGREED:**

1. Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in or offering to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery, and/or performing any other services requiring licensure pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:9-1 et seq., unless and until she is duly licensed by the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners to do so.

2. Respondent is assessed civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, in the amount of \$5,000.00 for violations of N.J.S.A. 45:9-1 et seq. Payment of the civil penalty shall be stayed provided that respondent complies with the terms of the

within Consent Order. Failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Order will automatically activate the stayed civil penalty, which will then be immediately due and owing. Upon becoming due and owing, payment of the civil penalty shall be submitted by certified check or money order made payable to the "State of New Jersey" and sent to William Roeder, Executive Director, Board of Medical Examiners, 140 East Front Street, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625.




