CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of information that: Maritza Perez, R.Ph., (hereinafter "Respondent") was arrested and charged with violations of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4.6a, in that she purposely did commit insurance fraud by making false statements of material fact in the submission of insurance claims for fraudulent prescriptions that had not been authorized by any physician; and with violations of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(2), forgery. On December 3, 2010, Respondent was admitted to the Passaic County Pretrial Intervention Program for a period of twelve (12) months.

These facts establish a basis for disciplinary action based upon professional misconduct pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e). It appearing that Respondent desires to resolve this matter without further recourse to formal proceedings and for good cause shown:

IT IS ON THIS 11th DAY OF May 2011.


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice pharmacy shall be and hereby is suspended effective on issuance of this Order, for a period of six (6) months, which shall be stayed and served as a period of probation.
2. Respondent shall notify the Board within 10 days after the successful completion of her Pretrial Intervention Program.
3. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order resolves this matter for the Board of Pharmacy only and is without prejudice to further action by other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct.
