CONSENT ORDER

TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THE
STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board"), by Paula T. Dow, Attorney General of New Jersey (Kim D. Ringler, Deputy Attorney General, appearing) based on a formal accusation filed January 19, 2011 brought by the Morris County Prosecutor alleging that Adina Alexescu, M.D. committed second degree assault and unlawful possession of a weapon, to wit, a ruler. The charges were resolved by way of Dr. Alexescu's entry into the Pre-Trial Intervention program on the same date for a period of twelve months. The PTI Order of

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Postponement requires Dr. Alexescu to complete 12 hours of community service, to continue counseling and to abide by any recommendations of the Division of Youth and Family Services.

The Board and Dr. Alexescu are desirous of resolving this matter without formal proceedings. She therefore consents and agrees to each and every term of this Consent Order without admitting any allegations of wrongful professional conduct.

The Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown, the parties have agreed to the following,

IT IS, therefore, on this 26th day of May, 2011,
ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Respondent shall serve a period of probation until January 19, 2012, her successful discharge from P.T.I. or the final resolution of the criminal charges, whichever occurs latest.
- 2) The conditions of probation shall include
 - (a) compliance with the conditions of the January 19, 2011 Pretrial Intervention Order,
 - (b) continued participation in the Professional Assistance Program and compliance with its recommendations, if any;


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(c) continued compliance with recommendations and/or conditions imposed by the Impairment Review Committee of the Board; and




