This matter was first opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of information pertaining to Respondent, Ida M. Carideo, M.D. On March 29, 1999, Respondent pled guilty to charges of federal mail fraud conspiracy and unlawful receipt of Medicare kickbacks. She was sentenced to fifteen months in prison followed by three years of probation, and ordered to pay \$28,390.60 in restitution. Subsequently, following a hearing before the Board, the Board entered an order of revocation of Respondent's medical license on February 14, 2001. In January 2011, Respondent, by her attorney, John R. Orlovsky, Esq., petitioned the Board for reinstatement.

In support of Respondent's petition for reinstatement,

Respondent supplied documentation of her completion of a remedial course in ethics; completion of a remedial course in compliance, billing, and coding; additional continuing medical education courses completed; a letter of reinstatement to the federal Medicaid/Medicare programs; and a letter of support from Louis Baxter, M.D., of the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey. In addition, Respondent appeared with Mr. Orlovsky and Dr. Baxter before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board on June 22, 2011. Upon consideration of the records available to the Board, the Board is satisfied that Respondent has successfully completed all of the requirements for reinstatement as set forth in the 2001 order of revocation and has demonstrated current competency to resume the practice of medicine.


The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,
