CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Court Reporting (hereinafter the "Board") upon receipt of a reinstatement application for certification as a court reporter in this State filed by Nadine M. Bachmann-Gazic, C.C.R., on or about September 11, 2008.

Review of this matter revealed that Ms. Bachmann-Gazic was initially certified as a court reporter in this State on or

about May 28, 1993. The Board's records indicate, and the Board finds, that Ms. Bachmann-Gazic's certificate expired in or about June 2008 and that she failed to renew timely for the 2008-2010 licensure period. Therefore, as authorized by N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b), the certificate of Ms. Bachmann-Gazic to practice court reporting in this State was administratively suspended without a hearing following her failure to renew the certificate within thirty (30) days of its expiration date.

Additionally, N.J.S.A. 45:15B-3.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:43-7.1(a) require that certificate holders complete fifteen (15) continuing education credits for biennial certification renewal. N.J.A.C. 13:43-7.1(a) specifically requires that the certificate holder complete the required credits during the preceding biennial period. Therefore, for the biennial renewal period of 2008-2010, certificate holders were required to complete fifteen (15) continuing education credits during the period of July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2008.

During its review of the respondent's reinstatement application, Ms. Bachmann-Gazic submitted information which indicated that she had completed a total of seven (7), of the required fifteen (15), continuing education credits during the allotted time period of July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2008.

The Board, at its March 2008 meeting, voted to reinstate Ms. Bachmann-Gazic's certificate and granted her a three (3) month extension to fulfill the requirement of the completion of fifteen (15) continuing education credits. To date, respondent has failed to demonstrated to the Board that she has satisfied the continuing education requirements for the 2008-2010 biennial renewal period.

She has now [OR SHE FAILED TO COMPLETE OUTSTANDING CREDITS WITHIN EXTENSION PERIOD] submitted documentation that demonstrates that she has satisfied the requirement but not within the time period required by law

The Board therefore finds that Ms. Bachmann-Gazic failed to complete the remaining eight (8) continuing education credits for the 2008-2010 licensure period. The Board concludes that these facts as detailed above establish a basis for disciplinary action.

However, the Board has concluded that sufficient mitigating circumstances, including the current economic difficulties and the requirements of Executive Order #2 issued by Governor Chris Christie on January 20, 2010, exists permitting it to alter its intended sanctions.

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings; and the respondent

acknowledging and not contesting the findings of fact and conclusion of law made by the Board and waiving any right to a hearing; and the Board having been satisfied that the within resolution adequately protects the public health, safety and welfare; and for good cause shown:

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 17th day of October

OCTOBER 2011 ORDERED that:

1. Respondent, Nadine M. Bachmann-Gazic, C.C.R., is hereby formally reprimanded for failing to timely complete the required number of continuing education credits, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h), N.J.S.A. 45:15B-3.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:43-7.1(a).

2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of **\$800.00**, which shall be stayed in its entirety, for failing to complete the required number of continuing education credits during the preceding biennial period, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h), N.J.S.A. 45:15B-3.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:43-7.1.
