

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Real Estate Appraisers Board (the "Board") upon receipt of respondent Robert Mikalouskas's response to a continuing education audit conducted by the Board for the January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 renewal period.

A Provisional Order of Discipline ("POD") was filed on April 8, 2011 provisionally suspending respondent's license to practice real estate appraising in the State of New Jersey and imposing a \$3,500 civil penalty based upon his failure to respond to a continuing education audit and failure to demonstrate completion of required continuing education.

In response to the POD, respondent submitted correspondence stating that he is no longer an active real estate appraiser, has not provided appraisal services for almost three years and is currently employed in a different industry. Respondent requested that his license be cancelled.


The parties desiring to resolve this matter, in lieu of further proceedings to finalize the Provisional Order of Discipline, respondent waiving any right to a hearing, it appearing that there is good cause for entry of this Order, and respondent and the Board agreeing to its entry;

IT IS on this 7th th day of December, 2011

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent hereby voluntarily surrenders his license to practice as a real estate appraiser in the State of New Jersey, with prejudice to reinstatement. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of his license.


