**ORDER RESCINDING A
PROVISIONAL ORDER OF
REVOCATION
FILED MARCH 3, 1994**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") on behalf of Paula T. Dow, Attorney General of New Jersey, by Wendy Leggett Faulk, Deputy Attorney General, upon receipt of information that a Provisional Order revoking the license of Richard W. Henderson, M.D., to practice medicine within the State of New Jersey was erroneously filed on March 3, 1994.

Dr. Henderson is the holder of License No. MA04566600, which was issued on January 1, 1985, and which is currently expired. His

address of record is in Delaware. The Provisional Order proposing the revocation of Dr. Henderson's license was based on erroneous findings that his medical licenses in Tennessee and North Carolina had been revoked in 1992. Unbeknownst to the Board at that time, the physician whose licenses had been revoked in those states was never licensed in New Jersey; he merely shared the same name, i.e., "Richard W. Henderson."

The Board, having determined that the Provisional Order was erroneously entered, lacked any legal basis, and other good cause having been shown:

IT IS ON THIS 2nd day of December 2011


ORDERED that:

1. The Provisional Order revoking the license of Richard William Henderson, M.D., is hereby rescinded *nunc pro tunc*, retroactive to the date of entry, March 3, 1994. All records at the Board regarding Dr. Henderson's licensure shall reflect that the Provisional Order was filed erroneously.

2. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Delaware Department of State, Division of Professional Regulation, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, National Practitioner Data Bank.
