This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Real Estate Appraisers Board (the "Board") during a continuing education audit conducted by the Board for the January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 renewal period. In response to an audit letter seeking proof of completion of continuing education, Anthony P. Campanella ("respondent") submitted a letter indicating that he had lost his certificates in a move.

A Provisional Order of Discipline ("POD") was filed on October 28, 2011 provisionally suspending respondent's license to practice real estate appraising in the State of New Jersey and imposing a \$2,500 civil penalty for failure to demonstrate completion of required continuing education and providing two

false answers on his biennial renewal application.

In response to the POD, the Board received a telephone call informing the Board that respondent was retired from the practice of real estate appraising, was ill, and would be willing to voluntarily surrender his license.


The parties desiring to resolve this matter, in lieu of further proceedings to finalize the Provisional Order of Discipline, respondent waiving any right to a hearing, it appearing that there is good cause for entry of this Order, and respondent and the Board agreeing to its entry;

IT IS on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2012

**HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:**

1. Respondent hereby voluntarily surrenders his license to practice as a real estate appraiser in the State of New Jersey, with prejudice to reinstatement. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of his license.
