: FINAL CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry (hereinafter the Board) upon information concerning allegations that Corey Bett (hereinafter Respondent or Mr. Bett) was practicing dentistry without a dental license. Respondent is not licensed or registered to provide dental care in the State of New Jersey.

An undercover Enforcement Bureau investigation provided a basis to allege that Mr. Bett repaired a denture in exchange for payment. According to the investigation, Mr. Bett also offered to make a denture for the undercover investigator for a separate fee despite the investigator not having a prescription for the denture.

The Board finds that these actions are in violation of

N.J.S.A. 45:6-13 (prohibition of practicing dentistry unless licensed and registered to do so).

Respondent, Mr. Bett, though his counsel, without making any admissions to the above conduct, but being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and agreeing to waive any right to same, and the Board finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare and for other good cause shown, and all parties agreeing to the terms of this Order;

IT IS ON THIS 11<sup>th</sup> DAY OF July, 2012,  
ORDERED THAT

1. Respondent, Corey Bett, shall immediately cease and desist from any and all acts constituting the practice dentistry in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18.2(b)(1).

2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18.2(b)(2), in the amount of \$5,000.00. Respondent shall pay \$1,000.00 and the remaining \$4,000.00 shall be stayed for five years. If during the next five years, Respondent is found liable for any violation, then the Board shall require him to pay the remaining \$4,000.00 plus any costs or penalties associated with the new violation. Alternatively, if Respondent does not commit any violation during the five year period, then the remaining 4,000.00 shall be discharged.

3. The civil penalty shall be due no later than thirty (30) days following entry of this order. Payment shall be submitted by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be forwarded to Jonathan Eisenmenger, Executive Director, State Board of Dentistry at 124 Halsey Street, Post Office Box 45005, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Respondent is permitted to make payments over the course of four months in equal installments to the Board without accruing any interest. Full payment must be received by the Board within four months from the date of this filed Order.

4. Failure to comply with any provision of this Order or remit any and all payments required by this Order will result in the filing of a Certificate of Debt and may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.

5. The entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action by other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct.

6. The Order constitutes full and final resolution of the charges in this matter pending before the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry.


