: FINAL CONSENT ORDER  
DANIEL CAMPIAN :  
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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry (hereinafter the Board) upon the filing of an Administrative Complaint on December 15, 2011. Mr. Campian, at that time pro se, filed an Answer on January 15, 2012.

The Complaint herein alleges that Mr. Campian practiced dentistry on at least three people, C.L., M.L. and an undercover Enforcement Bureau investigator, at his dental laboratory in Toms River, New Jersey. According to M.L. and C.L., Respondent took impressions of their mouth in preparation of making dentures for them. In at least one case, dentures were made though were a poor fit. In the other case, M.L. cancelled her order with Respondent following the impressions. Neither C.L. nor M.L. had a prescription for the dentures.

The undercover investigation revealed that Mr. Campian repaired a denture in exchange for payment. He also offered to take impressions and make a denture for the undercover investigator's relative for a separate fee despite the investigator not having a prescription for the denture.

Respondent is not licensed or registered to provide dental care in the State of New Jersey.

The Board finds that these actions are in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:6-13 (prohibition of practicing dentistry and regulated dental services unless licensed and registered to do so).

The matter was retained by the Board. Respondent, Mr. Campian, through his counsel, Flavio Van Boekel, Esq., being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and agreeing to waive any right to same, and the Board finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare and for other good cause shown, and all parties agreeing to the terms of this Order;

IT IS ON THIS 25<sup>th</sup> DAY OF July, 2012,  
ORDERED THAT

1. Respondent, Daniel Campian, shall immediately cease and desist from any and all acts constituting the practice dentistry in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18.2(b)(1).

2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18.2(b)(2), in the amount of \$15,000.00.

Respondent shall make payment of the civil penalty as follows:

Respondent shall submit payment in the amount of \$1,000.00 no later than thirty (30) days following the entry of this Order.

Respondent shall pay an additional \$1,000.00 no later than sixty (60) days following the entry of this Order. Thereafter,

Respondent shall make ten payments of at least \$600.00 in monthly installments without accruing any interest.

3. The remaining \$7,000.00 due as a civil penalty shall be stayed for five years. If during the next five years, Respondent is found liable for any violation of this Order or the rules and regulations administered by the Board, the Board shall require Respondent to pay the remaining \$7,000.00 plus any costs or penalties associated with the new violation.

Alternatively, if Respondent does not commit any violation during the five year period, then the remaining \$7,000.00 shall be discharged.

4. Payment shall be submitted on the first day of each month by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be forwarded to Jonathan Eisenmenger, Executive Director, State Board of Dentistry at 124 Halsey Street, Post Office Box 45005, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

5. Failure to comply with any provision of this Order or

remit any and all payments required by this Order will result in the filing of a Certificate of Debt and may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.


6. The entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action by other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct.

7. The Order constitutes full and final resolution of the charges in this matter pending before the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry.


