HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:


1. Respondent Mauricio J. Sanchez, M.D. is issued an unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey.


2. Respondent shall pay the total amount of penalties, costs and fees of \$12,000, as detailed in the April 11, 2011 Consent Order, as follows: (a). As respondent is currently unemployed, he shall notify the Board within one (1) week of his obtaining full-time employment; and (b). Within thirty (30) days of the commencement of said employment, Respondent shall begin making installment payments to the Board in the amount of \$666.66 per month for the next eighteen (18) months. Said payments shall be via certified check or money order made payable to the Treasurer, State of New Jersey and forwarded to William Roeder, Executive Director, New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, 140 East Front Street, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183.

3. The \$12,000 due and owing pursuant to this Order shall be collectible by either the Board or the Division of Consumer Affairs (the "Division") at the sole discretion of the Board. In the event that Respondent fails to make any payment due under the terms of the preceding paragraph, and following reasonable notice and the opportunity to cure, his license to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey may be summarily suspended. The Board or the Division may file a certificate of debt at their sole discretion.


